2 tsp sugar

½ tsp salt

170ml passata

100g mozzarella

2 tbsp parmesan

Small handful of fresh basil

75g green pesto

75g mushrooms

Handful of cherry tomatoes

100g ham (if vegetarian perhaps feta or goats cheese)

Handful of rocket
