You will learn through a mixture of theory discussions and demonstrations, and lots of practical work to create your own designs and pieces.

Course Details

This class will provide the skills, knowledge and tools required to safely cut and form glass and will give you the opportunity to design and produce a number of different pieces of jewellery over the 5 weeks. All pieces will be kiln fired by the tutor each week ready for the class the following week.

How progress and success will be recorded:

All jewellery from each week will be reviewed and assessed at the start of the next session, allowing students to identify areas of improvement. Confidence in cutting and forming the glass will improve each week as we move through the course and this will be reflected in the finished pieces.

Materials required for first week:

Additional Costs:

All tools for use in the class will be provided by the tutor. Each person will have a pack with basic tools available for use each week and there are some specialised items that students will have to share during the session.

Glass, silver wire and jewellery fixings will be required each week and there will be materials costs of between £15-£25 over the 5 weeks, depending on what you use.
