Teaching & learning methods used:

Each week the topic will be introduced using PowerPoint and a short handout.

Relevant examples of artists work will be discussed.

The students will spend the majority of the time applying this knowledge in a practical drawing and painting exercise

The session will close with a short discussion and feedback about observations, learnings and discoveries. The objectives for the following week will be discussed.

Course Details

This course aims:

- To increase the learners' enjoyment of drawing and painting.
- To encourage their personal development.
- To introduce techniques and materials to widen the learners visual vocabulary

Classes will provide tips and techniques to broaden the learners understanding of the creative process and how best to achieve their desired outcomes.

The sessions will be designed so that the learners can build on their previous knowledge. Each session will focus on a specific topic, (line, tone, texture, pattern, atmosphere, colour theory). The final project will encourage the use of all skills learnt over the term.

How progress and success will be recorded:

The students will be able to assess their progress by considering their progress over the term. There are no grades for this course

Materials required for first week:

Sketchpad, pencil, watercolours, brushes.
